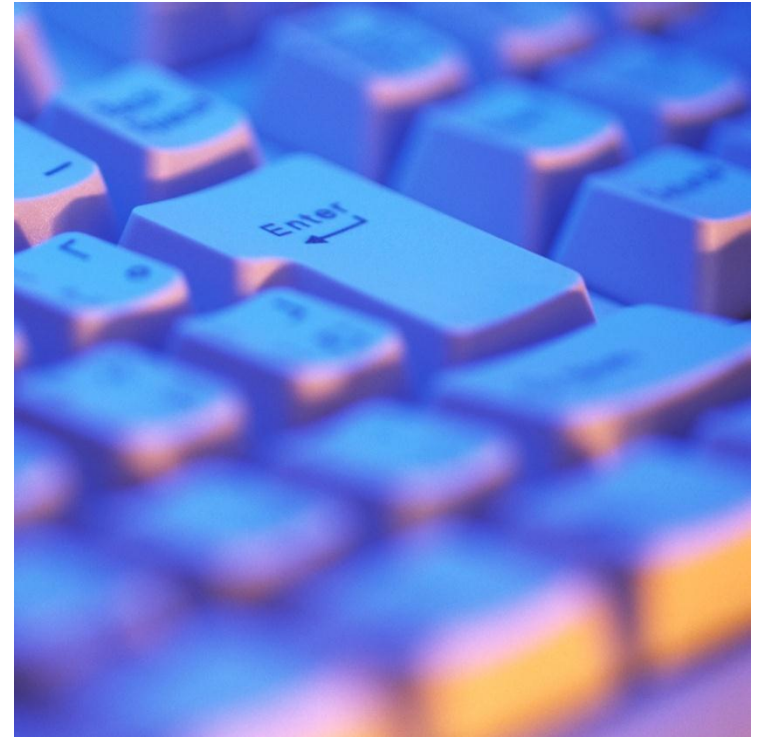

Spring 2013 Registration Reminders

- Should register for courses that fulfill Liberal Arts Requirements, the Ground Floor, and Foreign Language (if you choose); Guidelines were provided in last advising session
 - Last advising powerpoint available at: <http://www.gabelliconnect.com/freshman-advising>
 - 6 required courses prior to SO Year: Calculus, Finite Math, Composition II, Ground Floor, Macroeconomics, Microeconomics
 - Other course selections should be discussed with me *prior* to registration
 - **Only Rose Hill Classes (“R” sections)**; No “L” Lincoln Center (except LC Japanese/Russian), “E” Evening (except Ground Floor), or “C” School of Professional and Continuing Studies Courses.
- Registration Dates
 - Wednesday, November 28, 2012: Students who have earned 24-55 credits.
 - Friday, November 30, 2012: Students who have earned 0-23 credits.***
- Check to ensure you do not have a HOLD on your account ASAP
- Have plenty of back-up classes ready!

Having Trouble?

- May be a FCRH only course for their core curriculum (Eloquentia Perfecta); can only take English 2000 Eloquentia Perfecta class
- Reserve Closed: Looks open, but may have spots reserved for FCRH students
- May not be eligible due to other reasons (pre-requisites, etc.)
- May have reached your credit limit: **17**
 - If you think you will be registering for more than 17 credits, you must see me **PRIOR** to registration
- Don't wait – register for a different course/section – better to register and drop than not register at all
 - Come to see me for help – if I can help, you can always drop the other class
- If an IT problem, contact the Help Desk at 718-817-3999 or helpdesk@fordham.edu
- You may be “locked out” of registration due to the number of students registering simultaneously; just keep trying
- Some students experience trouble with their computers; consider trying a computer lab
- Make sure **ALL** of your additional credits have transferred **BEFORE** registration



Updated Final Exam Schedule

- Due to the hurricane, the fall 2012 final exam schedule has changed:
 - Tuesday, December 11: All Tuesday classes will meet as scheduled; no longer a reading day.
 - Wednesday, December 12: All Wednesday classes will meet as scheduled; no longer a reading day.
 - The exams that were to be held on the last day of reading period (Dec. 12) will be moved to Saturday, Dec. 15, with Accounting in the morning and Modern Language in the afternoon.
 - Thursday, December 13: This will become a “Monday,” and all Monday classes will meet as scheduled; no longer the first day of final exams.
 - The exams that were scheduled for the 13th will be moved to other days within the current exam period: on three days (December 14, 17, 20) there will be three exams scheduled.
 - Students who end up having three exams on one day will be able to reschedule one to a separate day.
 - Friday, December 14: Exams begin, concluding as scheduled on December 20.
 - Saturday, December 15: Rescheduled exams that had been planned for December 12.
 - December 14, 17, 20: Additional exam rescheduled from December 13.
 - **Please note: if you have three exams scheduled in a given day, inform me immediately!**



Tutoring

- **GSB STUDY CENTER: BUSINESS**
