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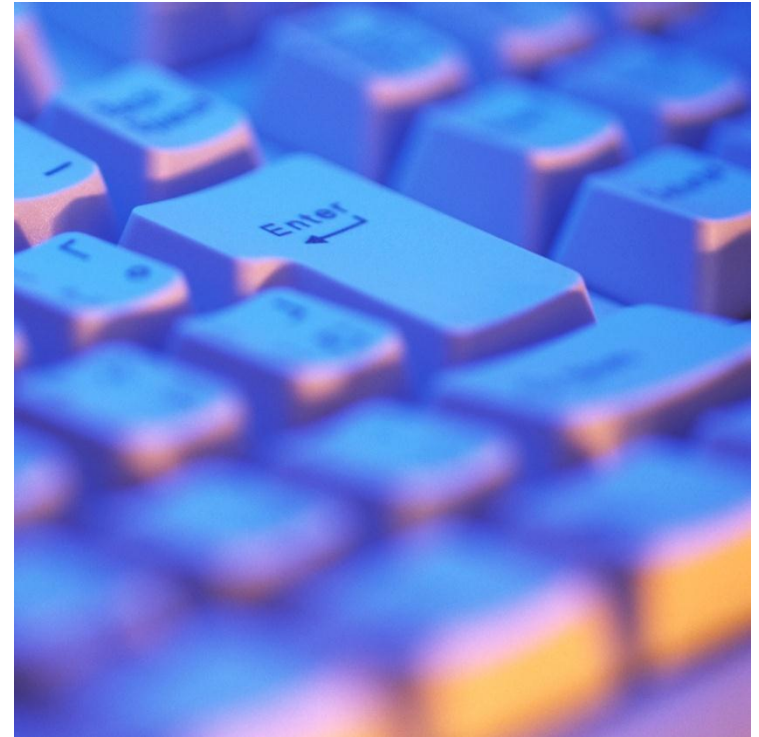

  - Will get input from Ernst & Young representatives, as well as student leaders from Dorothy Day Center and Multicultural Affairs

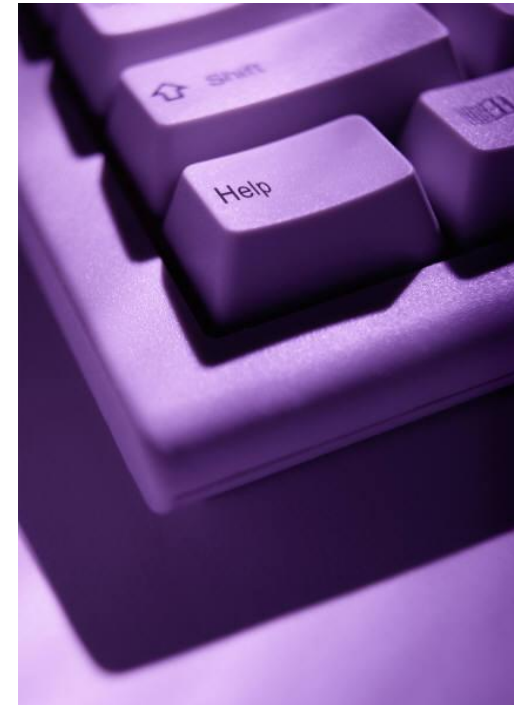

- **MATHEMATICS**

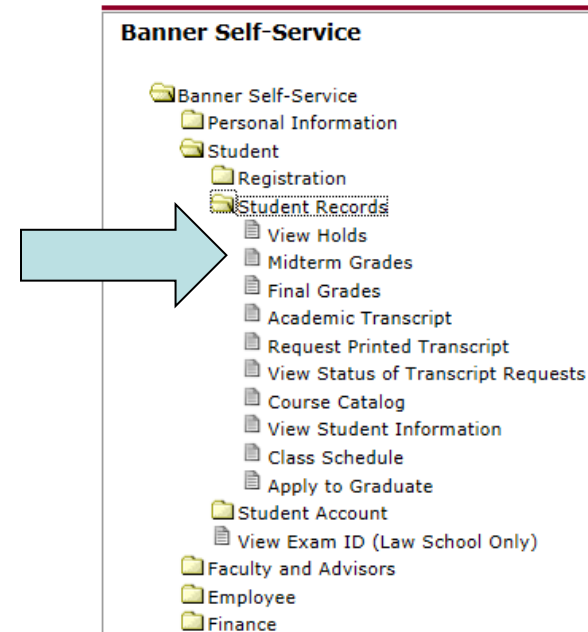
- The Math Help Room is located in JMH 410. Math Room Hours: M- F 10:00-4:00. No appointment is necessary.
