Selection Criteria

In order to be considered for a scholarship, you must:

- Be an accounting professional or student not currently enrolled in Becker's CPA Exam Review at time of scholarship notification.
- Meet the requirements to sit for the CPA Exam at the time of enrollment in Becker's CPA Exam Review.
- Demonstrate a financial need in preparing for the CPA Exam through a personal statement.
- Submit a letter of recommendation from an employer/manager, professor, community leader or clergy member along with your application.
- Demonstrate through a personal statement, the traits important to Newt Becker: high moral character, strong leadership qualities and a commitment to community service.
- Be a U.S. resident.
- As this is a needs based scholarship, it is not valid for applicants that are employed by or have accepted a position at a firm or corporation that reimburses for the CPA Exam Review
- Scholarship is non-transferable.
- **Selected recipients must enroll in Becker's CPA Exam Review by June 30, 2014.**
